Two days vs. Three days

What will be the same for both programs?

- Ohio Academic Standards incorporated into the curriculum.
- Forty minutes of centers time for independent and guided learning (4 students per group).
- Moms and Grandmas Night as well as Dads and Grandpa's Night.
- Three parent led parties (Thanksgiving, Christmas, & Easter).
- Christmas Cantata and end of the year graduation.
- Amazing art projects that help to improve small motor development and listening skills.
- Exciting learning themes and a variety of stimulating dramatic play opportunities.
 - Monthly chapel with the preschool class.
- Mother Goose Day! (Mother Goose will visit and the children will dress up and recite poems for her!)

What is enhanced for the three-day program?

- Increased academic instruction time and social interaction.
- In addition to centers the children will participate in two learning groups (8 students per group) daily to target Math, Language Arts, Writing, or Science.
 - Increased occasions for active large motor development and enjoyment.
 - One additional field trip.
 - Bonus art projects.
