

Trinity Lutheran Preschool

The Trinity Lutheran Preschool Program is designed to meet the individual child's social and educational needs. The program is based on the following three fundamental keys:

- A Christ-centered curriculum
- An experiential learning environment
- A successful collaboration with parents and teachers.

Trinity's Pre-school Program uses a character-building curriculum focusing on Biblical values. Prayer time, Bible stories, and children's Christian songs are incorporated to enhance the curriculum. Children enrolling in our program must be three (3) by Sept. 30th and be potty trained.

The classroom environment consist of centers in which the children to learn how to socialize and communicate with each other. Wigwams and igloos also are a part of the centers to inspire the children to use their creativity and the gymnasium is used for gross motor skill development. Classroom centers include:

- Art center - Encourages the child to use their creativity to design their own art projects. This center is also used to practice using scissors and glue as well as to learn other fine motor skills.
- Learning Center - Small group table area, used by the teacher, to work on letters boxes, writing letters, and math concepts as well as introducing new concepts
- Sand box Center - The contents of the sand box changes weekly using such items as rice, corn play doe and sand. This is a great center for tactile learners. We also try to go to the gym once a week and work on large motor skills.

Trinity's is proud of its Pre-School Program and welcomes parent participation and collaboration with the teachers. Also, parents are encouraged to observe the classroom as well as attend field trips and help with classroom parties. Formal conference sessions are held twice a year to discuss the child's progress within each area of the curriculum. Folders are sent home with every child for parents to send notes to school as well as for the teacher to return messages.
