PARKING REMINDERS

As our facilities are “landlocked”, parking restrictions exist and are strictly enforced. For the safety of the children and to facilitate bus traffic flow, there is no parking along the east side of Walnut Street at any time between the hours of 8:30-3:15 on school days. The playground/parking lot on the west side of Walnut Street may be used before 8:45 a.m. and after 3:00 p.m. for parking purposes but is not to be used between the hours of 8:45-3:00 due to its use as a playground during these hours. Parking is permitted along the west side of Walnut Street and along all of the side streets at all hours. Please be respectful of our neighbors – don’t block their access to their home driveways. Additional parking is located across the alley behind the church and school buildings.
