C.E.A. News

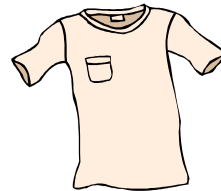

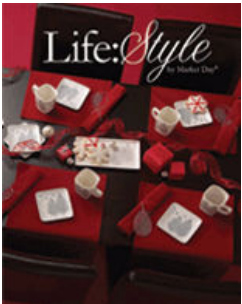


BICYCLES

Our Christian Day School Committee asks that only those pupils in grades 3 through 6 be permitted to ride their bicycles to school without the escort of an adult. We know from experience that bicycle riding can be extremely hazardous, especially with all the road construction around town right now. Parents will instruct their children in the "rules of the road". All bikes ridden to school must be in safe, operable condition. All bicycles must be properly parked in the racks provided and secured with a padlock to discourage tampering. They are not to be used during the school day nor are they to be ridden on school grounds or playground areas. Pupils who disregard bicycle safety rules will not be allowed to continue riding their bikes to school.
