OPEN TEACHING POSITIONS AT TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

As many of you are aware, our early childhood education teachers—Mrs. Nikki Lambert and Mrs. Jenny Holsopple—will not be returning next year. They have been faithful servants for Trinity for the last several years, and are following God's lead to other calls in life. We are beginning the process of find replacements for Mrs. Lambert and Mrs. Holsopple. Below is a job description for the positions of early childhood education:

1. Applicants should be certified by the State of Ohio or are able to meet the standards for such certification.
2. A normal school year will begin in September and will conclude in May.
3. Each teacher will be responsible for four classes of no more than 16 students in a self-contained classroom. Each class will meet for not less than 62 sessions, each 2.25 hours in length.
4. Communicates effectively with children, commending and reinforcing good conduct and achievement on part of the pupils.
5. Will supervise and direct the early childhood aide and any volunteer in compliance with duties outlined in their specific job description.

800 yard run – 6th grade boys – Joey Dougherty set a new record of 3:07

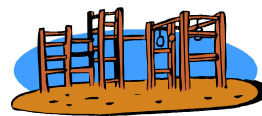
